NH SFI State Implementation Committee Members:

2011 was another positive and productive year for the New Hampshire SFI State Implementation Committee (NH SIC). The committee continued its strong support of the NH Professional Logger Program (PLP) and NH Project Learning Tree (NH PLP), while devoting additional resources to other diverse outreach, research and educational programs.

Below please find a brief summary of NH SIC's 2011 membership and outreach funding:

In 2011, the NH SIC membership/participants included:

- 10 Program Participants (with the addition of a new Eastern White Pine sawmill)
- 3 Program supporters
- 1 Forestry association
- 1 conservation organization
- 2 government agencies
- 1 timber harvester
- 1 University/Cooperative Extension employee

In 2011, 77 percent of the NH SIC's budget of \$31,285 went directly towards funding logger and landowner education and outreach programs:

- \$17,500 to the New Hampshire Professional Loggers Program
- \$3,000 to support NH Project Learning Tree
- \$500 to UNH Cooperative Extension
- \$516 to the establishment of a domain name and development of a new website

The Committee appreciates the generous support from all its members. Participant members not only contribute financially to the SIC and its outreach initiatives, but company and organization representatives put in valuable time and effort to ensure that resources are spent wisely and effectively.
